### Fiscal Updates - Katie Craft

- Katie distributed and discussed the Region 4 Financial Status Report SFY 2019
- As a region at the end of March 2019 we should be at 75% or below we are at 78.61% which is a little above
- We do not have the 2020 Fiscal Year Budget yet

#### Statewide - Jamie

- We're focused on the CWG Reports making sure we're meeting those recommendations
- There's still a continuous trying to get the Caseload Standards to where we need to be at. They're trying to get Supervisors Caseloads down 1 to 5

### Region 4 - Jamie

- Social Butterfly Initiative was Jamie Pippins idea to try to increase the number of mothers and fathers we interact with
- Revamping Residential We're looking at our Kids in Residential. In terms of overall Out of Home CHINS; Region 4 has the highest number of kids in Residential. Allen County and Noble County have a Residential Case Manager to focus on Residential Kids
- We're working on bringing LCPA's, Service Providers and DCS together to staff these kids once a month to get these kids out of Residential

#### **County Updates**

<u>Allen</u> - (Alexys Vosmeier, Director) – We hired our 3<sup>rd</sup> Division Manager (D.M) Heather Rouns. We will hire our 24<sup>th</sup> Supervisor by the end of today. We are working tirelessly on the remodel of this building.

"Social Butterfly Initiative"- we've seen some really big improvements in our contacts with fathers and mothers. Especially with our fathers, there's been a huge improvement

<u>DeKalb</u> – (Wesley Husselman, Director) – We had some slight FCM turnover. Our "Social Butterfly Initiative" statistics are looking good.

<u>LaGrange</u>- (Kathryn Stephenson, Director) – We are currently fully staffed. We have 2 FCM's in Cohort. One will graduate in May and the other will graduate in June. We are still at the same location with no lease; not sure what's going to happen with that or where we will end up

Noble County (Jamie Pippin for Amanda Herendeen, Director) - They have 2

FCM's graduating Cohort within the next week and another FCM starts today. Their building is remodeled! April is Child Abuse Awareness Month. Noble County will have their activity starts tomorrow at 9:00 a.m. each year they give out the "Judge Kramer Award"

<u>Steuben</u> – (Ron Lahmeyer, Director) – We had an FCM graduate Cohort last week so we are fully staffed. "The Social Butterfly Initiative"

<u>Whitley County</u> (Karena Hernandez, Director) – We lost 2 FCM's who transitioned to other positions. We have 2 FCM's in Cohort. One will graduate in May and one will graduate in June. We are working toward our building expansion
