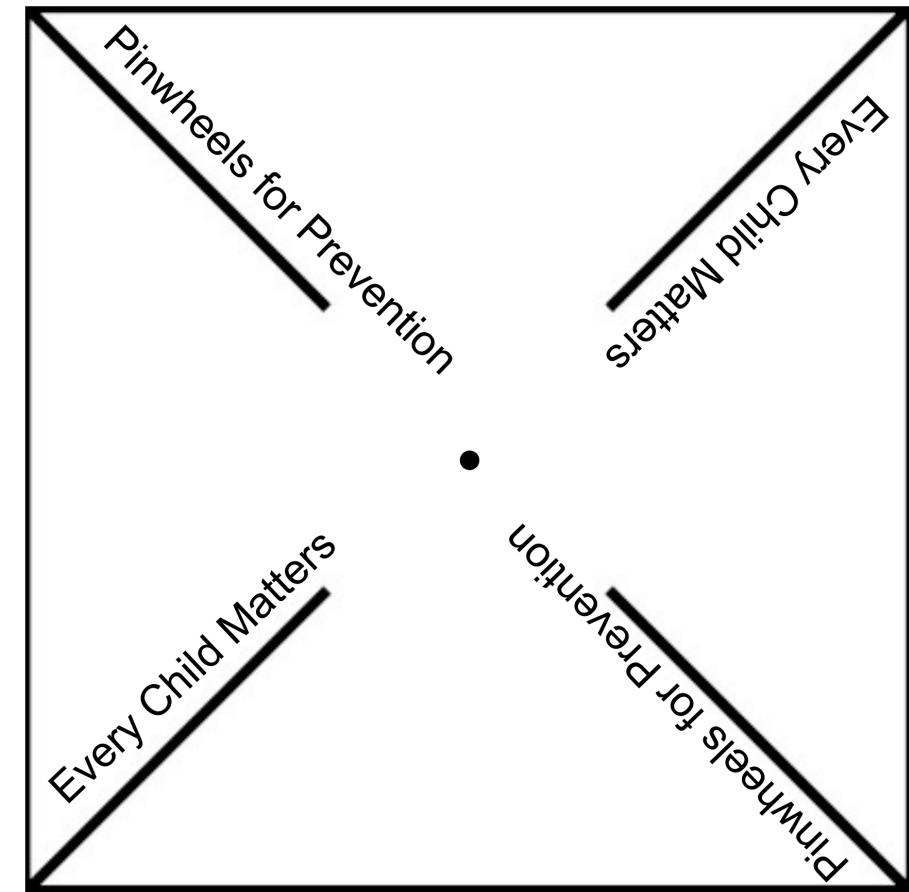


# Fun activity checklist
