The purpose of the meeting is to allow for public comment on the SSBG State Plan and Pre-Expenditure Report for FFY 2025 prior to submission to the US Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children and Families, Office of Community Services. The SSBG State Plan and Pre-Expenditure Report include Indiana agencies receiving SSBG funds and their intended use, including information on the types of activities supported and the categories of individuals to be served. SSBG funds are used to support a broad array of social services for children, adults, older adults, and other special populations. Discrimination on the grounds of race, color, sex, age, disability, national origin, or ancestry is prohibited in all activities funded by SSBG.
