

What types of placements are available? Children may be placed in a licensed resource home, a group home or child-caring institution, or other court-approved facility. Children may also be placed in an approved relative home, as well as with a non-relative who has a bond with the family. This is referred to as “kinship care”. Approved caregivers may choose to become licensed foster parents, to receive funding through a per diem. Approved caregivers who become licensed are not required to care for additional children.
