- 1. The Indiana Elevators, Escalators, Manlifts, and Hoists Safety Codes Committee (Committee), subcommittee of the Fire Prevention and Building Safety Commission (Commission), was called to order by Committee Chairman Michael Corey at 9:05 a.m. on Tuesday, January 21, 2020.

2. Roll Call/Attendance

Attendance was taken via the attendance sign-in sheet. Chairman Corey noted that a quorum was present, with six (6) voting members in attendance at the beginning of the meeting.

3. Review and Action on Meeting Minutes from Tuesday, December 17, 2019

Committee Secretary Douglas Boyle advised the Committee that he was unable to finish the Committee's meeting minutes from the Tuesday, December 17, 2019 meeting prior to today's meeting. He then advised the Committee that he will have the Tuesday, December 17, 2019 meeting minutes ready to present with the Tuesday, January 21, 2020 meeting minutes at the Committee's Tuesday, February 18, 2020 meeting.

4. Committee Review of Proposals for Code Change to ASME A17.6-2017 and ASME A18.1-2017

Director Boyle stated that he had procured a physical copy of ASME A17.6-2017 if any of the members would like to reference it for the purpose of bringing forth proposals for code change. He also advised that the Committee would likely choose to adopt this code book by reference. Before the Committee begins its review of this code book, Director Boyle noted that he will need to meet with Matthew Cronley to estimate the cost of new suspension means installations, as it relates to the fiscal impact analysis; though, Mr. Cronley believed that this will result in a cost savings. A summary of these cost estimates will be presented to the Committee at next month's meeting. Gary Herrington submitted twenty-four (24) proposals for code change to ASME A18.1-2017 for the Committee's consideration. For reference, the finalized proposals for code change, as amended and voted on by the Committee during the meeting, are attached to the end of this document. The Committee took the following actions on each proposal for code change:

- a. Proposal No. 86: ASME A18.1-2017, Section 1, 1.3 DefinitionsWITHDRAWN.
- b. Proposal No. 87: ASME A18.1-2017, Section 1, 1.3 Definitions
 - Justin Guedel advised to strike the following language: "except townhouses" and "and townhouses", as it is already stipulated in statute. The proposal for code change should also be revised to check the box "Delete and substitute as follows," as opposed to "Change to reads as follows."
 - Motion to approve as amended (John Watson); second (Gary Herrington)
 - APPROVED AS AMENDED with three (3) amendments.
- c. Proposal No. 88: ASME A18.1-2017, Section 1, 1.3 Definitions
 - Motion to approve as submitted (John Watson); second (Gary Herrington)

- d. Proposal No. 89: ASME A18.1-2017, Section 2 Vertical Platform Lifts
 - Proposed Amendment(s): After discussion, it was determined that the proposed addition should be moved from Section 2(A) to Section 1.1.5, essentially giving the amendment its own section within the model code.
 - Motion to approve as amended (Joe Albertson); second (John Watson)
 - APPROVED AS AMENDED with one (1) amendment.
- e. Proposal No. 90: ASME A18.1-2017, Section 2.3.1.6 Vertical Platform Lifts
 - Proposed Amendment(s): After discussion, the Committee determined that the last sentence of the proposal should be deleted from the proposal without substitution: "The wire rope shall meet section 2.5 Suspension and support means."
 - Motion to approve as amended (John Watson); second (Gary Herrington)
 - APPROVED AS AMENDED with one (1) amendment.
- f. Proposal No. 91: ASME A18.1-2017, Section 3.3.1.6 Inclined Platform Lifts
 - Proposed Amendment(s): After discussion, the Committee determined that the last sentence of the proposal should be deleted from the proposal without substitution: "The wire rope shall meet section 3.5 Suspension and support means."
 - Motion to approve as amended (Joe Albertson); second (John Watson)
 - APPROVED AS AMENDED with one (1) amendment.
- g. Proposal No. 92: ASME A18.1-2017, Section 4.3.1.3 Inclined Stairway Lifts
 - Proposed Amendment(s): After discussion, the Committee determined that the last sentence of the proposal should be deleted from the proposal without substitution: "The wire rope shall meet section 4.5 Suspension and support means."
 - Motion to approve as amended (Joe Albertson); second (John Watson)
 - APPROVED AS AMENDED with one (1) amendment.
- h. <u>Proposal No. 93: ASME A18.1-2017, Section 5 Private Residence Vertical</u> Platform Lifts
 - Motion to approve as submitted (John Watson); second (Gary Herrington)
 - APPROVED AS SUBMITTED.
- i. <u>Proposal No. 94: ASME A18.1-2017, Section 6 Private Residence Inclined</u> Platform Lifts
 - Motion approve as submitted (John Watson); second (Joe Albertson)
 - APPROVED AS SUBMITTED.
- j. <u>Proposal No. 95: ASME A18.1-2017, Section 7 Private Residence Inclined Stairway Chair Lifts</u>
 - Motion approve as submitted (John Watson); second (Joe Albertson)
 - APPROVED AS SUBMITTED.
- k. <u>Proposal No. 96: ASME A18.1-2017, Section 10 Routine, Periodic, and Acceptance Inspections and Tests</u>

- The Committee discussed striking "routine" from the title but could not come to a final agreement on the amendment. Gary Herrington advised that he would withdraw this proposal to do additional research and then submit a revised proposal.

- 5. Continue Discussion on the Prospect of the Fire Prevention and Building Safety Commission Adopting a Written Competency Examination to be completed in Applying for an Indiana Elevator Mechanic License [Indiana Code § 22-15-5-12(b)(2)(B)]

Justin Guedel presented a draft application for the Committee's review. He advised that this was simply a rough outline to give the Committee some semblance of what the applicant would need to submit. Some of the Committee's members were concerned about how the educational requirements would be regulated, and whether the lack of stringent requirements would present an opportunity for unqualified individuals to circumvent this portion of the application. Mr. Guedel stipulated that this licensing process would generally be reserved for those coming from out of state where a licensing program is not in place or do not possess reciprocity with the State of Indiana. Additionally, the applicant would have to provide a thorough list of all jobs held within the industry, as well as a signed affidavit from the licensed mechanic who oversaw the work. This inspector would then have to provide comprehensive documentation of the tasks completed and dates on which they were performed. Overall, Director Boyle stated he felt the department was heading in the right direction, in terms of preparing a sufficient application, but some loopholes may still need to be resolved in statute to ensure that the licensing process produces thoroughly trained applicants. It was encouraged that the Committee provide written comments to Mr. Guedel, so that they may be provided at the Commission's next regularly scheduled meeting.

6. Other Business – Review of Scheduled Meeting Dates through June 2020

Director Boyle provided the Committee with a complete schedule of meeting dates from January 2020 through June 2020. He hopes that the Committee will be finished with its business by this point. Chairman Corey adjourned the meeting. Director Boyle thanked everyone for coming. Chairman Corey adjourned the meeting.

7. Plan Forward – Set Agenda for Tuesday, February 18, 2020 Meeting

The Committee will continue its review of Gary Herrington's submitted proposals for code change to ASME A18.1-2017, and, if time permits, the Committee will begin reviewing ASME A17.3-2017. The Committee will also aim to wrap up any further discussion on the draft elevator mechanic license application.

8. Adjournment

Chairman Corey thanked the members for their service. Chairman Corey adjourned the meeting at 11:24 a.m.
