2. Roll Call/Attendance

Attendance was taken via the attendance sign-in sheet. It was determined that a quorum was present, with six voting members in attendance.

3. Review and Action on Meeting Minutes from Tuesday, September 25, 2018

Chairman Corey presented the meeting minutes from the Committee's Tuesday, October 30, 2018 meeting. Chairman Corey called for any additions and corrections to the minutes. Hearing no additions or corrections, a motion was made to approve the minutes with no additions or corrections, followed by a second. The motion was voted on and carried.

4. Reconsideration of Proposal #34: ASME A17.1 Section 8.6.1.7 Periodic Tests

Upon reviewing the Committee's Tuesday, October 30, 2018 meeting minutes, Steve Stuard advised the Committee that he believed the Committee needed to re-open Proposal #34 to discuss the fiscal impact statement that is provided on the proposals. Mr. Stuard advised that he believes the proposed code change is asking for further observance and testing of all initiating devices outside of what is currently required in code, which may likely created additional costs for contractors and/or owners. A motion was made to reopen Proposal #34 for the Committee's discussion, followed by a second. The motion was voted on and carried.

After discussion, the Committee determined that additional research is needed to determine the potential fiscal impact of Proposal #34, and if current fire alarm code requirements (NFPA 72-2010, Chapter 14) require testing of all initiating devices. Jeff Cooper advised the Committee that he would speak with fire officials, in order to provide clarification. A motion was made to table Proposal #34 until the Committee's January 2019 meeting, followed by a second. The motion was voted on and carried.
