

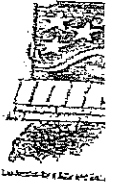





 This is a small rural two-room Amish School with an occupant load of less than 70. The manual fire alarm system required by Section 907.2.3 will not be installed.



The only difference between the system proposed and the required system is the addition of a manual pull station at the exit doors. Given the small size of the building these pull stations are not necessary.


