





Hosted **14** exercises for **1,086** participants




Issued **15,280** new fire and rescue certifications

Reached **5,417** students from **603** departments




Issued **3,457** new EMS certifications



Trained **1,063** first responders in the National Incident Management System (NIMS)






Assisted in **36** arrests leading to **12** convictions*



Responded to **3** Hazmat incidents and conducted **121** explosive magazine inspections




Conducted **151** Radiation investigations

Issued **1,027** firework permits/licenses




Graduated **8** students from the FEMA Basic Academy




Help **15** individuals obtain their Professional Emergency Manager (PEM) certification.




Deployed the K-9 unit **28** times




Activated the State Emergency Operations Center **5** times to support local disasters.




Supported **15** special events with command vehicles and other IDHS resources.




Deployed the Mobile Command Center **7** times and supported **10** counties for real-world incidents.






Inspected **2,362** amusement rides
