Douglas Boyle informed the Committee that next month's meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, September 25, 2018, starting at 9:00 a.m. in the Teleconference Media Center of Indiana Government Center South. He also advised the Committee that any proposal for code change submissions for the Committee's September 25th meeting are due by the end of business (4:30 p.m.) on Tuesday, September 18, 2018.

One member asked Chairman Corey if the Committee still intended to review ASME A17.6-2010, even though the standard is not statutorily required to be adopted into the code. Douglas Boyle advised that he had obtained a copy of ASME A17.6-2010, as requested by the Committee at its first meeting. Chairman Corey advised the Committee that he would inform the Fire Prevention and Building Safety Commission at its next meeting on Tuesday September 4, 2018 that the Committee would at the very least review ASME A17.6-2010, in order to evaluate if it would be beneficial to adopt the standard into the new code.
