- G. State Fire Marshal Report James Greeson
  - 1. Fire Prevention and Safety Grant Approved- IDHS plans to purchase five thousand smoke detectors with the ten year lithium battery each year. Five hundred Deaf and Hard of Hearing smoke alarms will also be purchased each year. There is an application on our website where you can apply. We will work with the local Fire Departments and the Red Cross to distribute these. There were a reported 93 fire fatalities in 2018. We are working to reduce this number.
  - 2. Fire Marshall Leadership Seminar- The first seminar will be Feb 9 at the Shelbyville Intelliplex. The second seminar will be Feb 23 Jasper Habig at the Community Center. The last one will be March 9 Warsaw at the Government Center. Free lunch will be provided. Instructors who attend the seminars will be awarded 8 in-service hours. Some of the topics covered will be Mental Health, Cancer Prevent and Public Safety. There will also be time allotted for discussion. You can self-enroll through your Acadis account.
- H. Director of Training/Preparedness & Planning John Brown
  - 1. Department changes- Departure of Elizabeth Westfall as the State Training Officer. Hiring of Michael Schantz as the Project Manager for the Training Division. Jeff Groh as the IDHS Chief of Operations.
- I. Academy Administrator Charles Heflin
  - 1. Fire Training Academy- We are working on the three year strategy for the Academy.
  - 2. Department changes Hiring of Elizabeth Westfall as the Quality Assurance Director. Zach Westfall is a contractor working to get Staff Rosters updated in Acadis.
  - 3. Updates to the following programs Health and Incident Safety Officer, Vehicle Machinery Operations and Technician, Fire Officer Strategy and Tactics, Hazmat Awareness, Operations, and Technician will be bought up to the current standard. Later this year we will be working on Firefighter 1 and 2 and Fire Investigator.
  - 4. Fire Board Rewrite We are nearing the end of this process and we should have a draft at the March Fire Board meeting

- 5. John Buchman Fire Officer 1 Beta update there were a few learning curves with this course. We are still working on processing all of the submitted paperwork.
