- 1. The Indiana Elevators, Escalators, Manlifts, and Hoists Safety Codes Committee (Committee), subcommittee of the Fire Prevention and Building Safety Commission (Commission), was called to order by Committee Chairman Michael Corey at 9:02 a.m. EST on Tuesday, November 17, 2020.

2. Roll Call/Attendance

Secretary Boyle conducted roll call noting that quorum was met with five (5) voting members in attendance at the beginning of the meeting. Secretary Boyle noted that quorum was narrowly met and asked Justin Guedel, Deputy General Counsel, whether an abstention on any of the following proposals for code change would cause the Committee to lose quorum. Justin stated that quorum would continue to be met in the case of an abstention, but a recusal would result in the loss of quorum. Seeing that a recusal was unlikely, the Committee continued on with its business. Clifford McDaniel joined the call during the discussion over proposals for code change bringing the number of voting members in attendance to six (6).

3. Committee Staff Updates/Announcements

 Status Update on Indiana Open Door Law and Public Meeting Requirements during the State of Indiana's COVID-19 Public Health Emergency – Douglas Boyle, Director of the Fire Prevention and Building Safety Commission & Justin Guedel, IDHS Deputy General Counsel

Secretary Boyle stated that it was his understanding that the open-door law and relaxed meeting requirements are now being tied to each new executive order issued. With that being said, he informed the Committee that Executive Order 30-47 extended the public health emergency through December 1, 2020. Additionally, it is unclear whether state boards and commissions will be able to host in-person meetings during the first half of 2021 because the State of Indiana is giving the General Assembly priority access to all governmental buildings – including the Indiana State Historical Library and the Indiana Government Center – for the first four (4) months of 2021. Secretary Boyle also informed that the Indiana Department of Homeland Security issued a statement requiring all boards and commissions to conduct meetings electronically until otherwise rescinded. Justin Guedel affirmed Secretary Boyle's statements and assessments.

b. New Committee Member – Brian Stanley (Indiana Department of Homeland Security Elevator and Amusement Ride Inspector)

Secretary Boyle informed the Committee that Brian Smith was officially appointed as the newest member of the Committee at the Commission's November 4, 2020 meeting. As such, Secretary Boyle thanked him for his commitment to serving the Committee and noted that he now has full voting privileges. Mr. Smith thanked the Committee for the opportunity and stated that he was looking forward to learning more about the process, as well as contributing to the Committee's decision-making.

4. Committee Review and Action on Meeting Minutes

Secretary Boyle informed the Committee that Bryston Sprecher, Administrative Assistant to the Fire Prevention and Building Safety Commission, had completed

drafts of the meeting minutes from the December 17, 2019; January 21, 2020; February 18, 2020; September 22, 2020; and October 20, 2020 meeting minutes. As these documents were provided on a short notice, he afforded the Committee discretion on whether to approve them or table them for further review. After some discussion, the Committee decided it was best to table the meeting minutes to afford each member ample time to look over each document; thus, Steve Stuard motioned to table all aforementioned minutes. Brian Smith made the second. It was voted on and carried.

a. Committee Review and Comparison of 2016 and 2019 editions of ASME A17.1

Steve Stuard prepared an analysis comparing the differences between the 2016 and 2019 editions of ASME A17.1, so that the Committee could come to a quick decision regarding which sections to adopt by reference. Unfortunately, the Committee did not have time to review this after finishing its discussions on the proposals for code change. Secretary Boyle advised the Committee to review Mr. Stuard's documents, and ASME A17.1 will be revisited at a later meeting to finalize it for the Committee's proposed rule.

7. Plan Forward

a. Set Meeting Date for December 2020

After some discussion, it was decided that Tuesday, December 15, 2020 will be the date of the next tentatively scheduled Committee meeting.

b. Set Agenda for December 2020 Meeting

The Committee will continue to review ASME A17.3-2017 and will revisit tabled Proposal #114. Secretary Boyle advised that he also hopes to bring forward a proposal to adopt ASME A17.6-2017, but he still needs to work with other IDHS staff to determine the fiscal impact of adopting ASME A17.6-2017 (likely savings to the regulated public). Time permitting, the Committee may also try to begin discussing Mr. Stuard's comparisons of the 2016 and 2019 editions of ASME A17.1.
