

HOW TO MAKE A FAMILY EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION PLAN



COLLECT INFORMATION

Create a paper copy of the contact information for your family and other important people

or offices, such as medical facilities, doctors, schools or service providers.



SHARE INFORMATION

Make sure everyone carries a copy of the plan in his or her backpack, purse or

wallet. You should also post a copy in a central location in your home.



PRACTICE

Have regular meetings to review your plan. This will ensure that all members of your

household know how to reach each other in an emergency.

If you are using a mobile phone, a text message may get through when a phone call will not. This is because a text message requires far less bandwidth than a phone call. Text messages may also save and then send automatically as soon as capacity becomes available.
