THE SUGAR CREEK FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, VIGO COUNTY,
FOR APPROVAL OF A FIRE FIGHTING APPARATUS, BUILDING AND EQUIPMENT LOAN
PURSUANT TO IC 36-8-13-6 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$600,000


A petition was filed by the above named taxing unit for approval of the issuance of a Fire Fighting Apparatus, Building and Equipment Loan (pursuant to IC 36-8-13-6) in the principal amount of \$600,000 for a term of six (6) years, to provide funds for the District to purchase a 2006 Vision Series 1500 GPM 75' Aerial fire truck. The Department has reviewed the petition and all other matters pursuant to IC 6-1.1-18.5-8. This Department takes the following action:

APPROVE:

Issuance of a Fire Fighting Apparatus, Building and Equipment Loan pursuant to IC 36-8-13-6 for Sugar Creek Fire Protection District, Vigo County, in the principal amount of **\$600,000** for a term not to exceed six (6) years to provide funds for the District to purchase a 2006 Vision Series 1500 GPM 75' Aerial fire truck. This approval is limited to the project(s) described in file 07-004 as presented to the Local Government Tax Control Board and the Commissioner for consideration.

To obtain a debt service rate for 2007 pay 2008, the unit must comply with the provisions of IC 6-1.1-17-3. In addition, on or before December 31, 2007, the unit must execute the above issue and file with the Department of Local Government Finance a final amortization schedule.
