

Roger McClellan Game Bird Area

Warren County, Indiana



Roger McClellan Game Bird Area is a 130-acre property. It was acquired in 2014 using Game Bird Habitat Stamp Funds, Bicentennial Nature Trust dollars, and donations from Pheasants Forever and the National Wild Turkey Federation. The property is named after Roger McClellan, who was well-known locally for his dedication to promoting game birds. He served as a dedicated volunteer to Pheasants Forever and was the previous owner of the land.

Access is by written permit only and is awarded only for hunting opportunities, research, and volunteer conservation work. No other access is granted. Call Willow Slough FWA at 219-285-2704 for more information.

Directions: From Pine Village, go east on S.R. 26. Turn south onto 725 E. Park by the wooden sign, just before the road turns to a "T" into 450 N.
