What License Do I Need for Small Game and Furbearer Hunting?

Squirrel • Rabbit • Frog • Turtle • Furbearer

17 and Under

Resident

- Annual Youth Consolidated Hunt/Trap License

Nonresident

- Annual Small Game Hunting License

** Youth are exempt from needing a fishing license to take frogs or turtles.*

18 and Over

Resident

Must have at least one of the following:

- Annual Small Game Hunting License
- Annual Small Game Hunt & Fish Combo License
- Annual DAV Small Game Hunting License
- 10-Year DAV Small Game Hunting License
- Annual DAV Small Game Hunt & Fish Combo License
- 10-Year DAV Small Game Hunt & Fish Combo License
- Any Lifetime Hunting License

Frog and Turtle

- You may also use an annual fishing license or any lifetime hunting or fishing license

Nonresident

Squirrel, Rabbit, Furbearer

- Annual Small Game Hunting License
- OR-
- 5-Day Small Game Hunting License

Frog and Turtle

- Annual Small Game Hunting License
