

Wilbur Wright Fish & Wildlife Area Total Solar Eclipse April 8, 2024

Thank you for considering experiencing the total solar eclipse at Wilbur Wright Fish & Wildlife Area. Keep this information in mind to ensure that everyone is safe and has a great experience during this rare solar eclipse event.

- Plan to travel to the property early and expect delays when leaving. Heavy traffic is expected after the eclipse. Bring snacks and water with you. Ensure you have enough fuel for safe travels home.
- It is important to keep roadways clear while enjoying the eclipse to ensure safe passage of emergency vehicles.
- Parking is limited to designated areas only. See the map below. The office parking lot supports 10 vehicles. There are no spaces for buses or RVs. We will close the parking lot once it is full. Overnight camping is prohibited. You are welcome to park in any of the designated parking areas and walk on levees or other areas. Foot travel is welcome.
- It is important to wear eclipse glasses while viewing the solar eclipse.
- Please remember to sign in at the self-service areas.
