

INFRMS: YOUR CLASSIFIED FOREST & WILDLANDS DATABASE

The Indiana Forest Resource Management System (INFRMS) was designed for you. It is located at <http://www.in.gov/forestryexchange/INFRMS/Default.aspx> and is a secure site, so you will need a user name and password.

Top Three Things to Do in INFRMS

- 1) **Complete your annual report.** Use the “Click Here to Submit Annual Report” button. Step-by-step instructions are available at http://www.in.gov/dnr/forestry/files/INFRMS_Annual_Reports.pdf.
- 2) **View the records for your classified tracts.** From the menu on the left, select Manage My Forest Land. In the popup window, click on the tract number to open that tract record. Click on the tabs on top of the tract record to view the various information. The Classified Program, Tract Map, and Management History are favorites among landowners.
- 3) **Update your contact information.** To change your address, email, or phone number, use My Account from the left menu. Remember to click the Save button after making your changes. For name changes, contact your district forester.
