Improvement harvest using single tree selection, group selection openings, and a shelterwood. The objective was to remove mature, damaged, and trees of declining health, as well as less desirable trees to improve the overall health, vigor, and composition of the stand. Much of the merchantable ash that were accessible by equipment were marked. Eastern white pine and Virginia pine were marked to regenerate those areas to a new cohort of native hardwood tree species.
