


Bidding will be at Martin State Forest office at 14040 Williams Road, Shoals, IN 47581

The sale has the following conditions:

The Buyer will provide an operational bulldozer on site or nearby during active operations. Wet weather may limit skidding/hauling. A pre-harvest conference must be attended by all crew members 3 days prior to the start of any logging operations. Administering forester must be present if harvesting trees within 100 feet of cultural features. Directional felling is required. A spotter should stop traffic on Low Gap Mt Olive Rd when trees are felled that could cause logging debris to fall in the road. Also, there are not any bat restrictions on this sale. Tops and other debris resulting from the harvest operation are to be removed from mapped intermittent streams, haul road and designated skid and hiking trails. As per the contract, the buyer shall complete closeout work within fourteen days of the removal of the last load of logs from the sale area, or the removal of harvesting equipment, whichever occurs first. Loggers are strongly encouraged to close out particular areas (ridges, bottoms, etc.) as soon they are finished in that portion. Logger is required to seed and straw log yards.

The timber specified in this document is Certified Wood. Indiana State Forests are certified by both the Sustainable Forestry Initiative® (SFI®) Program and the Forest Stewardship Council® (FSC®). Purchasers of State Forest timber may market state forest timber products as certified if they have the appropriate Chain of Custody certificate.

The FSC Certificate Number for Indiana State Forests is SCS-FM/COC-00099N. The FSC claim is "FSC 100%".

The SFI Certificate Number for Indiana State Forests is NSF-SFI-FM-6L841.

Sealed bid for such property will be received at the office of the Property Manager until the hour and date above set out, at which time and place all acceptable bids will be publicly opened and read aloud, and any bids received after the designated time will be returned unopened.

Bidders in good standing are required to submit a check (completely filled out) for an amount equal to or larger than five percent (5%) of their bid amount payable to the Indiana Department of Natural Resources with their bid as a performance deposit. Bidders not in good standing are required to submit a performance deposit for an amount equal to or larger than 10% or 20% of their bid, depending on the level of their standing as provided to them by the Indiana Department of Natural Resources. The performance deposit amount is not part of the total sale (bid) payment, but is a separate payment. Failure to comply with conditions and requirements of the executed contract may result in a forfeiture of a portion or all of this performance deposit.

The property will be sold under written contract to the responsible bidder making the highest

sealed bid, provided the bid is acceptable to the state. The winning bidder must make a payment equal to or larger than ten percent (10%) of the bid amount within fourteen calendar days of the bid opening. The winning bidder must return the executed timber sale agreements to the Indiana Department of Natural Resources within one month of the bid opening date. The remaining bid amount balance, if any, shall be paid within one year of the bid opening or prior to the start of harvest operations, whichever occurs first. The bidder may pay the entire bid amount within fourteen calendar days of the bid opening. Failure to pay at least a ten percent (10%) down payment or the full bid amount within fourteen calendar days from the date of bid opening will result in a forfeiture of all of the performance deposit. Failure to pay the total bid amount within the prescribed time will result in a forfeiture of all of the performance deposit and any down payment. The terms of the sale will be cash, the buyer to accept delivery of the property and to remove the property therefrom by June 11, 2022, which will be the expiration date of said contract. The Department reserves the right to accept and/or reject any and/or all bids. The Department (at its discretion) reserves the right to rebid the sale.
