Sale marked in red, blue and orange paint by Forester Laurie Burgess. Installment payments optional. 52 trees were cut during April 10-14 for cutter training. There are New Training Standards for State Forest Properties harvest operations: There will be a minimum of 1 person (crew and/or supervisor) on the site when it is active that meets the training standard which now includes Logger Training within the past 3 years and BMP training within the last 3 years as defined on the new training standard. No cutting or skidding restriction dates for this timber harvest.

Remarks:

There are 10 small openings ranging from 0.3 acres to 3.5 acres. The far west 1.4 acre opening is partially complete due to being utilized for timber cutter training in April. Most of the trees cut were Yellow Poplar. These include 23 Yellow Poplar sawtimber, 16 Yellow Poplar poles, 2 Black Oak sawtimber, 1 Red Maple pole, 5 Sugar Maple pols, I Sugar Maple sawtimber, 1 Chestnut Oak pole, 2 White Ash pole and 2 Largetooth Aspen pole. There are 3 log yard locations. The skid from the far west log yard is 1.3 miles to the far east section of the sale area. The cutoff pile near the far west log yard will need to be dispersed rather then left in a pile to meet new recreation aesthetic guidelines.
