


Warbler Woods Nature Preserve

County: Marion Size: 136 acres
Ownership: State Parks - IDNR



Location and Access

Parking and trail. In Fort Harrison State Park. From I-465, take 56th St exit (Exit 40) and head east on 56th St until you reach Post Rd (about 2 miles). At Post Rd, turn left (North) and go 0.5 mile until you reach the state park entrance. Follow park's signs to Delaware Lake Picnic Area parking lot. Take the Fall Creek trail or go north on the Harrison Trace trail in order to reach and walk within the preserve. The Harrison Trace is a 2.5 mile-loop trail with an asphalt surface for walkers, bicyclists and joggers.



Description:

This preserve is highly dissected with gentle slopes and floodplain forests, and it has a 0.6 mile of frontage along Fall Creek. There is a high quality herbaceous layer with spring ephemerals, and the site is utilized as nesting habitat by migrant birds, including the Cerulean Warbler and Brown Creeper. Lawrence Creek Nature Preserve, also within the State Park, is included on this map.
