Fort Harrison State Park to Host First Day Walk/Run January 1, 2015

Fort Harrison State Park, the Friends of Fort Harrison and the Fort Harrison Inn are hosting a 6k First Day Walk/Run on Thursday, January 1 @ 1p starting at the State Park Visitor Center. The Walk/Run is part of a series of First Day events hosted by the Indiana Division of State Parks on January 1 at State Parks across Indiana.

The Walk/Run follows a circular route and will take participants from the Park Visitor Center through Fort Harrison State Park to the Fort Harrison Inn, and then back into the State Park at the starting point. Light refreshments will be served at the Fort Harrison Inn for Walk/Run participants.

The Walk/Run is an informal event. The First Day Walk/Run is approximately 6k or 4 miles long. The Walk/Run is un-timed event. While there is no registration fee for this program, the usual State Park entrance gate fee applies. Children in strollers and leashed pets are welcome to attend. All participants are encouraged to dress for the weather which could include deep snow or cold, windy conditions. Participants must be able to physically complete a 6k course in winter conditions.
