2015 Soldier's Haunt October 24 at Fort Harrison State Park

The Museum of 20th Century Warfare and the staff at Fort Harrison State Park will host the park's annual Soldier's Haunt on Saturday, October 24, 2015 at Fort Harrison State Park, weather permitting.

The Haunted Hay-ride is scheduled from 8:30p – 9:15p on Saturday, October 24 behind the Reddick Shelter. The Haunted Hayride is approximately 45 minutes long and is not recommended for children under 10 or in strollers; no pets, please. The Haunted Hayride is limited to the first 60 participants; please no large youth groups at this time.

Family-friendly Halloween events are also scheduled on Saturday, October 24 from 3p – 4:30p at the park Visitor Center. Programs include Halloween Crafts, Pumpkin Decorating, and a Costume Contest.

A Weenie-Marshmallow Roast will be held at 5p around the campfire at the Walnut Shelter on Saturday, October 24. Participants are encouraged to provide their own hot-dog stick; weenies and marshmallows will be provided.

On October 24 an outdoor, family-friendly Halloween movie is scheduled on the sledding hill starting at 6:30p.m. – 8:00p.m. Bring your own lawn chair or blanket for the duration of the movie; pets are not recommended for this program.

Fort Harrison State Park is physically located at 59th and Post Rd in Lawrence, Indiana. There is no cost to the program; the normal State Park entrance fee applies. More information is available at 317-591-0122 Thursday – Monday, 8a – 4p. These are outdoor events; participants are reminded to dress for the weather.
