

Wander in the Woods at 9:00a *Program Location: Deam Wilderness Area*

FREE but registration is REQUIRED by April 30. Sign up by emailing jvance@dnr.IN.gov with your name, phone number, and number of people in your group (or call the Paynetown Activity Center at 812-837-9967). **Limited to 10 people; restricted to ages 16 and up.**

This is an all-day hike for people who love to explore unique, off-trail areas. We will be hiking through the Deam Wilderness along Frog Pond Ridge; this area is a "graben" that lies between two earthquake fault lines. The hike will feature fault-line geology, as well as spring wildflowers and ferns - including a delicate walking fern that grows on boulders in the graben. Participants must be physically fit and capable of hiking for 5 to 6 hours. A portion of the hike will utilize trails, but the majority will be off-trail over varied terrain.
