Mounds SP invites families to attend Hoosier Homestead Day on June 20th

Making an old fashioned toy, guessing the use of old tools and seeing live chickens are just a few of the attractions planned at Mounds State Park on June 20th.

Hoosier Homestead Day will run from 1 to 3 p.m. on the lawn of the historic Bronnenberg home.

The activities on June 20th will focus on the farming heritage of the Bronnenbergs. They were only of the first families to settle in the Anderson area and had to work the land to live here. Hoosier Homestead Day will honor those traditions.

The naturalists will be dressed in historic costume and will have extra costumes for members of the public to wear as they complete farm chores, tour the historic home, build a old-fashioned toy, and feed the chickens.

The event is free, though standard park entrance fees of \$7 per in-state vehicle and \$9 per out-of-state vehicle apply
