



# Salamonie Trapping Camp

at Salamonie Reservoir on October 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>, 2012

The DNR is partnering with Indiana State Trappers Association (ISTA) volunteers to host a special two-day Trappers Education Course at Salamonie Reservoir.

The program will include:

**Education on furbearer species biology**

**Trapping rules and regulations**

**Hands-on experience in setting traps and catching furbearers**

**Skinning, fleshing, and trap preparation**

The program will start at 9 in the morning on Saturday and Sunday with education on trapping techniques, ethics, regulations, and hands on experience. Attendees will set traps under guidance of a Trapper Education Instructor with the possibility of catching furbearers.

Attendees will have the option of free camping Saturday night at the Lost Bridge West youth campground near the Salamonie Interpretive Center. Trappers will not need a trapping license to attend this program, though bringing knee boots or waders is recommended. The gate fee will be waived for all participants.

**Trappers will need to pre-register by September 30<sup>th</sup>.** Pre-register and get more information, contact the Upper Wabash Interpretive Services at 260-468-2127.
