

GENERALIZED HYDROGEOLOGIC CROSS SECTION ALONG U.S. 36, HENDRICKS COUNTY, INDIANA

This cross section was originally constructed at a horizontal scale of one inch equals 2000 feet. In order to show the top and bottom of the Devonian-Mississipian New Albany Shale it was necessary to use two scales of vertical exaggeration. Above the 650 foot elevation the vertical exaggeration is 40X. Below the 650 foot elevation the vertical exaggeration is 20X.
