## 2020 Nomination Blue Ribbon School Wide Cut Scores: Exemplary High Performing Schools

These scores are used to determine "Exemplary High Performing" public schools as part of the nomination process measured by state assessments. They are also used to assist nonpublic schools in determining if they will qualify to apply for the award.

The cut scores indicate the percentage of students who passed the 2019 ILEARN (for grades $3-8$ ) and 2019 ISTEP+ (for grade 10) in each school when ranked. The pass rates reflect the students enrolled in the school for a minimum of 162 days and students are included in the school accountable for their education. The scores below represent the statewide school percentage at the $85^{\text {th }}$ percentile.
