Title II, Part A Preferred Technical Assistance Providers

The Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) has identified technical assistance providers available to assist schools both on-site and virtually, providing support for teachers, principals, and other school leaders in their work to improve the overall quality of instruction and ensure educational opportunity for all students. These technical assistance providers may provide a range of support to schools aligned with one or more of the following:

- Novice teacher and principal induction and mentorship;
- Meaningful evaluation and support;
- Strong teacher leadership; and
- Supporting a diverse educator workforce across the career continuum.

Following a critical review of qualifications specific to the priorities identified, the organizations below are aligned with the focus areas above. School leaders seeking assistance are encouraged to refer to this list and consider providers that meet their specific needs.¹

Novice Teacher and Principal Induction and Mentorship
