



**Indiana Education Scholarship Account
Special Education Services (APC) Award Amounts
2026-2027 School Year**

Indiana is committed to expanding quality educational opportunities to Indiana students. The Indiana Education Scholarship Account (ESA) is an annual program available to eligible students. The application to apply opens each year on March 1. Parents of eligible students or emancipated students who participate in the ESA program may use the scholarship funds to purchase approved educational programs, therapies, services, tuition, fees, and other approved expenses related to the student’s education from approved ESA entities. ESA is administered by the Indiana Department of Education (IDOE). ESA award amounts are determined by the student’s corporation of legal settlement and their level of disability. Eligibility for the program requires students to live in Indiana, be between 5 and 22 by October 1 of the applicable school year, and have an active Indiana IEP, SP, or CSEP. Siblings of eligible students may also qualify for ESA.
