

Special Education General Supervision Timeline

The Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) has provided the following timeline overview for assisting local educational agencies (LEAs) with monitoring and compliance reporting requirements under the U.S. Department of Education's Office of Special Education Programs pursuant to the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).

RDA Dashboard opens for LEAs to access their annual determinations and correction steps.

Child Count is certified by LEAs by December 13 and finalized on December 20 annually.

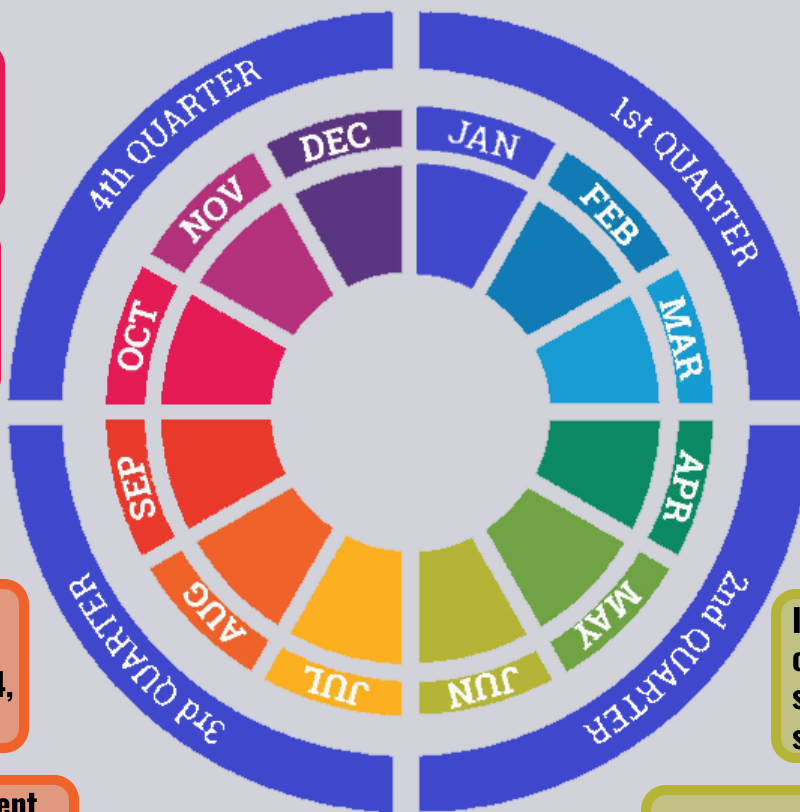
Universal technical assistance is available throughout the year upon request and through monthly online sessions.

The previous year's cohort graduation data is available.

IDOE finalizes and uploads data to the Results Driven Accountability (RDA) Dashboard.

IDEA Section 618 data is available and analyzed for reporting.

Graduation data is certified by LEAs on October 2 and finalized by October 13 annually.



Indicator 13 monitoring begins in March and continues through the summer.

Technical assistance is provided for Indicator 13 corrections.

Child count is certified by LEAs by April 1 and finalized on April 20 annually.

Notices of compliance and noncompliance are sent to LEAs reviewed for Indicators 4, 9, and 10.

IDOE's post-school outcomes survey is sent to students who exited services the previous year.

Indicator 8 data regarding parent involvement is finalized.

Indicator 13 notices of compliance and noncompliance are distributed to LEAs.

Alternate Diploma audit and request for supporting documentation

Discipline data is finalized for analysis.

Termination Records are certified by LEAs by July 12 and finalized by July 20 annually.

Evaluation data for Indicator 11 and 12 is finalized.

Public reporting on performance of each LEA on State Performance Plan/Annual Performance Report (SPP/APR) targets, no later than 120 days following submission of SPP/APR.
