## How to determine if a student passed the target language assessment

## ACTFL Assessment of Performance toward Proficiency in Languages (AAPPL)

Below is a sample of an AAPPL assessment report that would be sent to your school after the students complete the round of AAPPL testing. This table would be sent electronically to the school in an Excel format so schools can sort and upload the data to more easily determine eligibility and for easy uploading to data warehousing programs.

Given the nature of determining proficiency, it is important that the students meet the minimum level of Intermediate High (I-5) in all language domains. When viewing the table below, it can be noted that there are only two students who would receive the Certificate of Multilingual Proficiency recognition and they are highlighted in green. The areas that are preventing the other students from being eligible are circled in red. If a student demonstrates a proficiency level higher than Intermediate High, an Advanced (A) rating will appear on the scoring table. No averaging of scores is permitted.

## STAMP 4S Scoring Guidelines

Below is a sample of an STAMP 4S assessment report that would be sent to your school after the students complete the round of STAMP testing. This table would be sent electronically to the school in an Excel format so schools can sort and upload the data to more easily determine eligibility and for easy uploading to data warehousing programs.

Given the nature of determining proficiency, it is important that the students meet the minimum level of Intermediate High (6) in all language domains. When viewing the table below, it can be noted that there is only one student who would receive the Certificate of Multilingual Proficiency recognition and his name is circled in green. The areas that are preventing the other students from eligibility are circled in red. Numerical ratings above a six (6) are perfectly acceptable however a student cannot have a number lower than six (6) in any area in order to be eligible. No averaging of scores is permitted. Also, please note that a student must complete and have a numerical score for each language domain. Having a domain rated as "Not Ratable", "Not Started" or "Test Completed" is not sufficient to make a determination of a student's eligibility.
