



Applying for an Educator License: Quick Start Guide

Getting Started:

- 1. Log on to <u>https://license.doe.in.gov/</u>.
- 2. Create a profile in the License Verification and Information System (LVIS).



3. Write down your user name and password for future reference.

Applying for a License:

- 1. After logging in, click on Add Application on the right-hand menu bar.
- Select the appropriate license type. If you are unsure, current educators can find more information here: <u>http://www.doe.in.gov/student-services/licensing/current-educators</u>. Prospective educators can find more info here: <u>http://www.doe.in.gov/studentservices/licensing/prospective-educators</u>.
- 3. Choose the college where you completed your coursework.
- 4. Complete the criminal history check and submit the application.
- 5. You may check the status of your application at any time by logging in to LVIS and clicking on **Application Status** on the right-hand menu bar.
- 6. You may pay for your application by clicking on **Pay Pending Applications** on the righthand side menu bar.

Submitting a Professional Growth Plan:

- 7. On the LVIS home page, click on the **Professional Growth Plan** link on the right-hand menu bar.
- 8. Enter your PGP information and save.
- 9. Upon submission you should see a record of the PGP and any other PGPs you submitted.
- 10. Let your building principal know you have submitted your PGP. They will log in to the LVIS system and approve the PGP.
