- The Center for Whitley Youth presented a cohesive plan for after school Social Emotional Learning for elementary through high school aged youth. Multiple sections of application were very well developed resulting in maximum points being awarded for those sections.

Proposal Weaknesses:

- Transportation. Missing school corp. # on front page
