AP World History 2 provides an in-depth study into the history of the world starting with the beginnings of global trade through current issues facing our world. The online AP World History course will develop the skills necessary to arrive at conclusions on the basis of an informed judgement and to present reasons and evidence clearly and persuasively in essay format. The course will also assist students in developing skills in organizing information, deconstructing questions, and how to study, preparing them for future history courses.
