This course includes reviewing the 16 national career clusters and Indiana's Career and Technical Education Pathways, in depth investigation of one or more pathways, reviewing graduation plans, developing career plans, and developing personal and career portfolios. A project-based approach, including computer and technology applications, cooperative ventures between school and community, simulations, and real life experiences is recommended.
