Pursuant to IC 4-22, the Indiana Office of Small Business and Entrepreneurship ("OSBE") has reviewed the economic impact analysis for small business associated with rule changes contained in LSA Document 15-426 proposed by the Indiana Department of Education (DOE). The proposed rule Amends 575 IAC 1-9-15 to allow a driver to delay completing the cycle for turning the child alert notification system off when the bus ignition is turned off, amends 575 IAC 1-9-28 to clarify and provide additional specifications for the contents of first aid kits, amends 575 IAC 1-9-51 to include specifications for optional rear stop arms, effective 30 days after filing with the Publisher.
