Important Updates

Recent Commercial Food Recalls, USDA Foods are Not Affected

The following message contains important information about two commercial recalls that may affect schools. These recalls do not involve USDA Foods.

Recently, two manufacturers - Hillshire Brands Company (Sept. 27) and Foster Farms (Oct. 4) - recalled corn dog products that may be contaminated with extraneous material, specifically pieces of wood embedded in the batter.

Recalled products were not part of food distributed by the USDA for the National School Lunch Program. However, the products may have been purchased by some schools through commercial channels. Consumers and institutions, including schools, who have purchased these products are urged not to consume them. These products should be thrown away or returned to the place of purchase.

Department of Defense (DoD) Fresh Fruits and Vegetables Program Update with Local Food

You might have noticed more Indiana produce rolling onto the Fresh Fruits and Vegetables Order Receipt System (FFAVORS) catalog. In total, 368 schools have purchased local Indiana produce through DOD Fresh. Products from Noah's Poplar Produce (Salem), Lobenstein Family Farm (Saint Leon), and Family Farm Fresh (Rockville) are available for purchase. Starting this month, you will be able to see the exact farm you are getting product from on the What Chefs Want Farm to School Local Order Guide. This increases singlefarm traceability in large-scale distribution. Be on the look out for more products like sweet potatoes, winter squash, and acorn squash coming soon!
