NEW: AI is Computer Science - IDOE Partnering with Nextech to Celebrate CSEd Week

NEW: Continuum of Support

Pursuant to IC 20-32-8.5-2 and IC 20-32-5.1-20, IDOE developed the following guidance to help schools support students who are at risk of not being proficient in reading. This guidance focuses on using data and instruction to meet students' literacy needs. REMINDER: Keys to Literacy No Cost Professional Development for Early Literacy Endorsement

IDOE's Early Literacy Endorsement Professional Development is available to current eligible Indiana educators who hold a valid professional educator license and teach in a content area that involves literacy instruction for PK-5 students. Eligible licensed Indiana educators may participate, at no cost, in Keys to Literacy. Registration is available here for those who are eligible, but space is limited. REMINDER: Early Literacy Professional Development Approval

Educators who have completed 80-hours of professional development will complete this form to verify details of their training and upload their completion certificates. Once the professional development has been approved, IDOE will issue a confirmation letter that will be used by the educator to complete the early literacy endorsement application in LVIS.
