



2026-2027 INDIANA SAT ACCOMMODATIONS CROSSWALK

The **Indiana SAT Accommodations Crosswalk** helps educators understand the relationship between the College Board options in Services for Students with Disabilities (SSD) Online, the SAT accommodation options listed in IDOE Special Programs, and related daily accommodations. SSD Online accommodations automatically transfer to Test Day Toolkit (TDTK) and Bluebook. The paper-based SAT is only allowed for students that require a paper assessment accommodation. For additional information or descriptions of each accommodation and how these may be administered for other College Board assessments, refer to College Board’s Accommodations and Supports Handbook.

Human Reader for digital testing allows the student to receive the Human Reader accommodation while recording their answers in Bluebook. Human Reader for digital tests automatically includes 50% extended time.
