Gas Use Tax Holiday

On June 3, 2026, Governor Mike Braun updated his energy emergency declaration and extending suspension of the collection of Gas Use Tax and Gasoline Excise Tax. In accordance with that [executive order](#), the Indiana Department of Revenue (DOR) won't collect Gas Use Tax from April 8 through July 7 or Gasoline Excise Tax from May 6 through July 7, 2026.

If a business has traditionally filled out an IVT-1 form, there will be additional information shared about how the emergency declaration may impact that form.

DOR launches Tax Amnesty eligibility tool

Taxpayers are now able to check their eligibility status for Tax Amnesty 2026.

DOR is partnering with United Collection Bureau (UCB) to offer this limited-time opportunity for taxpayers to pay past due, eligible taxes and receive a waiver on related penalties, interest, and collection fees. Key elements of Tax Amnesty 2026 include:

- **Timeframe:** July 15 through Sept. 9, 2026
- **Qualifications:** Existing tax liabilities for all listed tax types for periods prior to Jan. 1, 2024

Available through INTIME at taxamnesty.in.gov, individuals and businesses may use the tax amnesty tool to check their eligibility to participate.
