Gas Use Tax Holiday

On May 6, 2026, Governor Mike Braun updated his energy emergency declaration, extending suspension of the collection of Gas Use Tax and adding a suspension of Gasoline Excise Tax. In accordance with that [executive order](#), the Indiana Department of Revenue (DOR) will not collect Gas Use Tax from April 8 through June 7 or Gasoline Excise Tax from May 6 through June 7, 2026.

Individual Income tax bills are coming

DOR's annual billing for Individual Income tax will begin **May 11, 2026**. Several options are available for customers to make timely payments.

Customers or tax practitioners with ePOA access can pay a tax bill in full or request a payment plan through [INTIME](#). INTIME's "Respond to a Letter, Bill or Notice" function (available after login) allows customers to inquire about a bill or provide additional information. Using this function

Amnesty is coming July 15

DOR is partnering with United Collection Bureau (UCB) to conduct a tax amnesty program between July 15, 2026, and Sept. 9, 2026. This means that taxpayers will have a limited-time opportunity to pay past due, eligible taxes and receive a waiver on related penalties, interest, and collection fees.

Outstanding tax liabilities for tax periods ending prior to Jan. 1, 2024, are eligible for Tax Amnesty 2026. A tax amnesty eligibility lookup tool will be available May 18, which will allow people to look up if they have any eligible liabilities.
