Power of Attorney update

DOR's Power of Attorney, [Form POA-1](#), has been updated, and no longer includes an expiration date. Customers requesting a new POA should begin using the updated form that does not have a 5-year expiration date. The prior version will continue to be accepted through Dec. 31, 2025, but will not expire.

The POA can be revoked only by written and signed notice. The revocation notice must include the name, address, and Social Security number of the taxpayer and the name of the designated representative that is being revoked. A new POA form must be completed if the taxpayer chooses to change their designated representative who can communicate on their behalf with the department. The name, address, and telephone number of the taxpayer's representative must be included on the new POA form.

Do your research before donating to charities

Are your customers interested in donating to charities assisting communities affected by crises and natural disasters? The holiday season is here, and various scams like fake charity promoters may use emails, websites, and altered caller IDs to appear as a real charity. The IRS offers the following tips to help protect your clients against these scams:

- Ask the caller for the exact name, website, and mailing address to confirm the charity is valid. The Tax Exempt Organization Search (TEOS) tool is useful to verify legitimacy.
- Remember: Do not feel pressured into making a payment at that exact moment. Charities are happy to receive donations at ANY time.
- Avoid providing gift cards or wire transfers when giving donations. Credit cards and checks are the safest ways to donate. Review the FBI's resources on [Charity and Disaster Fraud](#) if you encounter a fake or suspicious charity before you donate.
