Request an Extension of Time to File

The deadline for filing 2024 Indiana individual income tax returns is **April 15, 2025**.

Taxpayers needing additional time can request an extension of time to file their return via [INTIME](#). Indiana will automatically grant an extension if they have a federal extension of time to file from the IRS. However, if they expect to owe state taxes, they still need to file an extension request and pay at least 90% of the amount due by **April 15** to avoid penalty.

Filers can request it electronically via INTIME before the April 15 deadline without having to log in to request or make the payment. An [INTIME Guide to requesting an Extension of Time to File](#) is also available to help.

New INTIME Features

INTIME has made major changes affecting customers Feb. 13, 2025. New INTIME changes allow customers to be able to respond to a letter, notice, or bill as a non-logged-in user using their letter ID via a "Respond to correspondence" panel.
