Instructions for Indiana Tax Amnesty 2015 Agreement for Non-filing Taxpayers

General Information

Tax Amnesty 2015 is from September 15 to November 16, 2015. Taxpayers who are eligible to participate in Tax Amnesty 2015 but choose not to do so will be subject to double penalties at the end of the Tax Amnesty 2015 period.

Tax Amnesty 2015 is available to both individuals and businesses who owe past-due taxes for periods ending prior to January 1, 2013.

Taxpayers who failed to file the required Indiana tax return(s) or underreported tax liabilities on a previously filed tax return are eligible.

Taxpayers who participated in the 2005 amnesty program or the horse claiming tax amnesty program are not eligible for Tax Amnesty 2015.

How to Apply

Complete and return a signed Tax Amnesty 2015 Agreement with the required payment between September 15 and November 16, 2015.

File any missing returns for those tax periods for which you wish to participate in Indiana Tax Amnesty 2015.

File amended returns with the Agreement for any tax periods for which you underreported your tax liability.

Request permission from the department by November 16, 2015, to establish a Tax Amnesty 2015 payment plan.

For Businesses. Enter the exact business name, Federal Identification Number (FID), contact person, etc.

Total Amount Due. Enter the total amount of tax due as shown on your return.
