



## CDL Checklist

If you are a driver who needs a Commercial Driver's License (CDL), you must:

- Have a valid Indiana operator's license;
- Pass a DOT physical examination;
- Pass the written CDL test at any Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) license branch;
- Obtain a CDL learner's permit;
- Schedule and pass a skills test at an Indiana-contracted third-party CDL skills test site; and
- Upon passing the skills test, submit the Skills Test Certificate within 30 days to any Indiana BMV branch.
- Need a chauffer's license if the gross vehicle weight rating of the vehicle you're driving is between 16,000 and 26,000 lbs.
- Need a public passenger chauffer's license if you are transporting passengers for hire and have a seating capacity of less than 15 passengers (including the driver).
- Be aware of when you need to renew.
