*Indiana Design Manual* Chapter 72, Bridge Rehabilitation has been rewritten and now appears as Chapter 412, Bridge Preservation.

Notable revisions include the following

- 1. The chapter includes an expanded discussion on the distinction between Bridge Preventative Maintenance and Bridge Rehabilitation projects.
- 2. Bridge preventative maintenance treatments and associated bridge component condition ratings from the Bridge and Culvert Preservation Initiative (BCPI) have been incorporated into the chapter.
- 3. A Local Public Agency (LPA) may participate in bridge preventative maintenance activities once the agency has an INDOT-approved Bridge Asset Management Plan (BAMP). An LPA Bridge Agreement with FHWA is currently being finalized and will provide guidance on how to submit the BAMP.

- 4. Scour analysis and load rating requirements for Bridge Preventative Maintenance and Bridge Rehabilitation projects are defined for State and LPA bridges.
- 5. Design loading requirements for various bridge rehabilitation activities are defined.
