Recurring Special Provision 702-B-304, Permanent Deck Form Angles, revises *Standard Specifications* section 702.13(e) to include the following:

The vertical leg of angles used as form supports shall not extend higher than the top of the permanent metal form.

This requirement aims to ensure that form angle used in conjunction with permanent metal deck form will not protrude beyond the theoretical bottom of the deck as well as to preclude field cutting of the angle.

Designers should no longer include a visual representation of the deck form, angle, or the $\frac{1}{2}$ " protruding dimension of the angle leg on the plans. Only the minimum fillet dimension (typically $\frac{3}{4}$ in.) should be shown. Details relative to welding angles in the tension or reversal zone for structure steel members may continue to be shown.

Plans should be revised to reflect these changes for contracts whose Final Tracings submission due date is on or after September 1, 2017.
