FOOTNOTES:

- a. Rates for each school child are shown separately. They are not included with any other compensation rates. All other entries on this chart reflecting a rate for children show the rate payable for children under 18 or helpless. To find the amount payable to a 70% disabled veteran with a spouse and four children, one of whom is over 18 and attending school, take the 70% rate for a veteran with a spouse and 3 children, \$1,513, and add the rate for one school child, \$168. The total amount payable is \$1,681.
- b. Where the veteran has a spouse who is determined to require A/A, add the figure shown as "additional for A/A spouse" to the amount shown for the proper dependency code. For example, veteran has A/A spouse and 2 minor children and is 70% disabled. Add \$95, additional for A/A spouse, to the rate for a 70% veteran with dependency code 12, \$1,461. The total amount payable is \$1,556.

REVIEW THE LIST OF FORMS GIVEN BELOW. THESE ARE THE ONES THAT A VETERANS' service representative will most often encounter in the course of assisting veterans and their dependents or survivors, although the frequency of use will vary greatly. A well-stocked Veterans Service Office should have these forms in stock, proportionate to the frequency with which they are needed. In addition, many of the most commonly used VA forms may now also be downloaded from WARMS (<<http://www.warms.vba.va.gov/>>, *click on "VA Forms" in the left-hand sidebar*), which will greatly reduce the number of forms that must be kept in stock. Also, certain select applications may be directly completed and submitted on-line (see the online listing for the particular benefit).

Note that most of the forms are prefixed according to the VA activity which uses them. Note also that the list also includes several Department of Defense (DD) forms and Standard Forms (SF), as well as National Archive (NA) forms.
