Dear Veteran,

Your application for a Disabled Hoosier Veteran (DHV) license plate and placard has been approved. Take your signed State Form 32584 to your BMV License branch for final processing.

This entitles you to DHV license plates, for 1 or more vehicles and/or a placard. The license plate and placard are gold in color with blue letters and numbers and the universal handicap symbol (wheelchair). This entitles the veteran to park in any marked handicapped space, including parking meters designated only for handicapped persons, but the privilege is assigned to the disabled veteran, not to the vehicle.

The Disabled Hoosier Veteran license plate and placard allows for free parking at metered spaces in Indiana. However, a person other than the veteran is not entitled to the free parking privilege.

The placard carries the same benefits as the disabled Hoosier veteran license plate.

Please take the approved, stamped application to your local License Branch for further processing.

A current, non-expired, Disabled Hoosier Veteran (DHV) license plate or eligibility for the DHV plate also makes you eligible for the Golden Hoosier Passport at a reduced price. Take vehicle registration showing proof of the Disabled Hoosier Veteran plate or the approved Eligibility Certificate (State form 32584) to any state park, recreation area, reservoir, forest, historic site, museum, memorial or any other Department of Natural Resources (DNR) facility to apply for your Discounted Golden Hoosier Passport.
